In 2002, he won the 2002 Paul Selvin Award from the Writers Guild of America for his film "For Love or Country: The Arturo Sandoval Story". He also earned an Emmy Award nomination for his work on "Live From Baghdad". In addition to his work for HBO, Sexton joined forces with acclaimed filmmaker Alfonso Cuarón on "Children of Men", a futuristic dystopian tale that earned him an Academy Award nomination for Best Adapted Screenplay.
